Dear Honorable Presiding Judge Nelson:

Pursuant to Penal Code §933.05, the Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District is providing the following response to the 2013-2014 Grand Jury Report entitled Security Impact on Graduation Rates in Solano County High Schools.

Recommendation 1: All high schools in Solano County identify funding to implement the Resource Officer program.

The Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District has a strong partnership with the Fairfield Police Department. The District's current practice is consistent with the recommendation. Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District has a Resource Officer program and all comprehensive high schools have Resource Officers assigned to the schools.

Recommendation 2: All high schools take the necessary measures to ensure compliance with California Education Code 38003.

The District disagrees with the finding. The Grand Jury report states, "All high schools reviewed had Site Safety Supervisors." While the Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District employs campus monitors who wear identification badges, the District does not employ Safety Supervisors as defined in the Grand Jury report's referenced Education Code section.

California Education Code 38003 outlines the expectations for individuals employed as members of a security or police department of a school district. The recommendation will not be implemented because it is not warranted; the Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District does not operate a security or police department as defined in this section of the Education Code.
