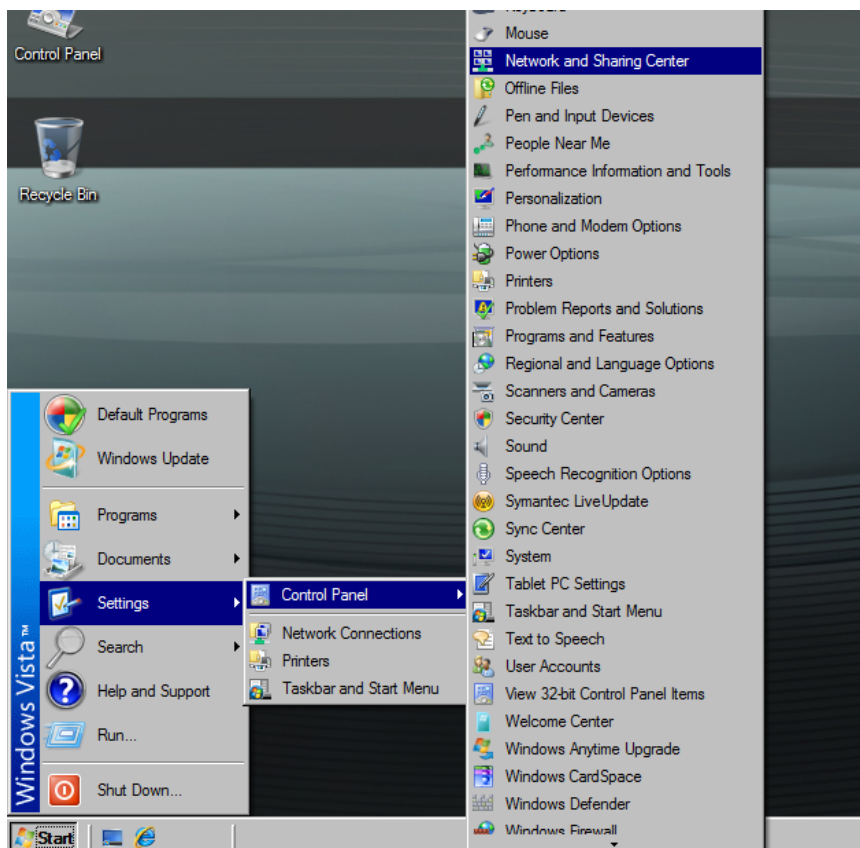




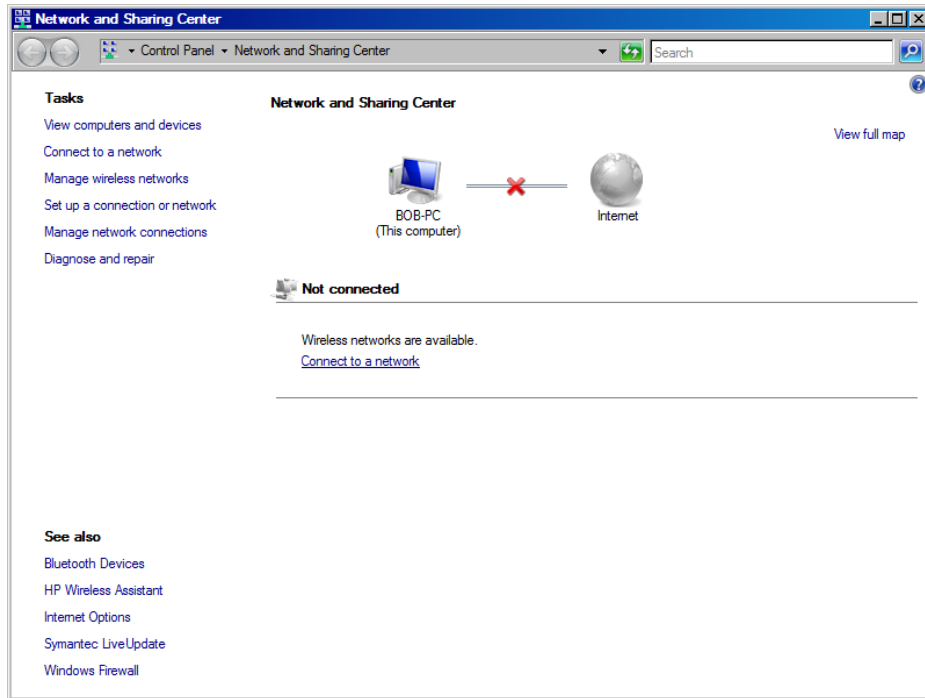
Superior Court of California, County of Solano Wireless Access: Windows Vista

The court provides a free Internet access point or "hot spot" for the benefit of the Public (during normal business hours) that have portable computers capable of receiving wireless signals. This will allow users to access the Internet from their laptop computers when sitting within range of an access point. The following is a step by step instructional on how to connect to the wireless network using Windows Vista.

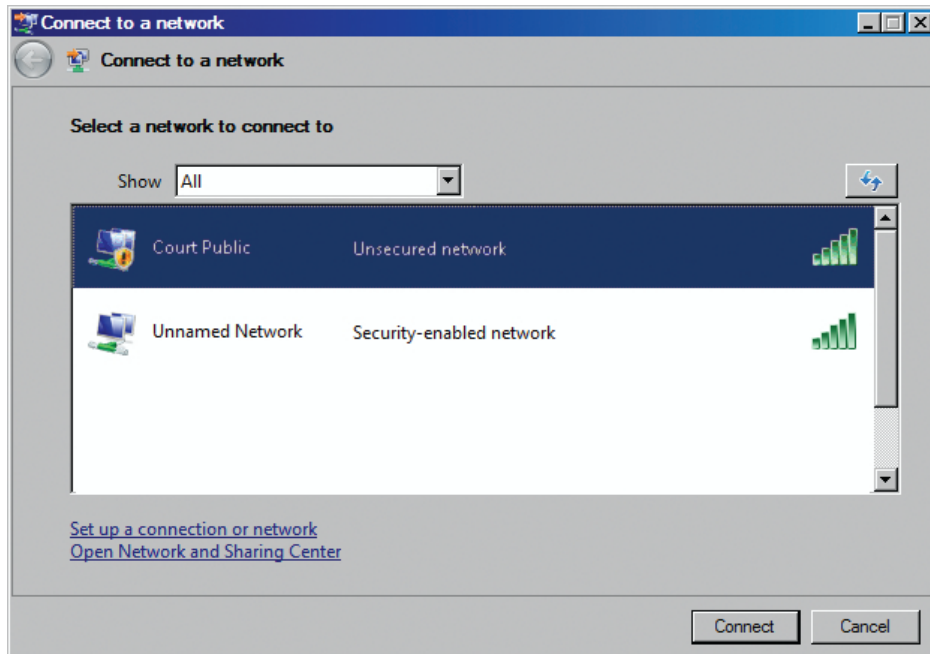
Go to **Start** then **Control Panel** and select **Network and Sharing Center**.



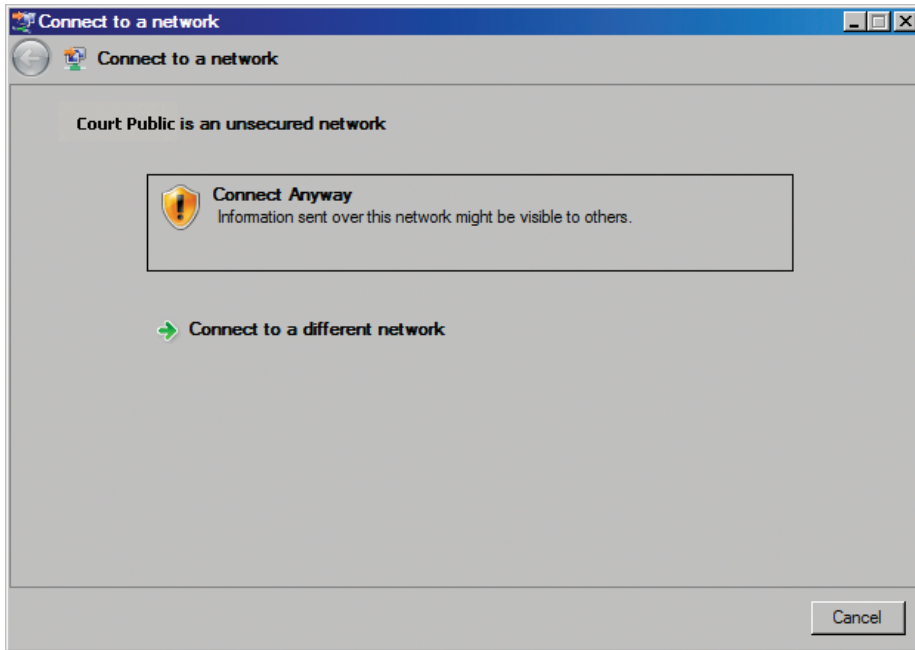
Click on **Connect to a Network** task



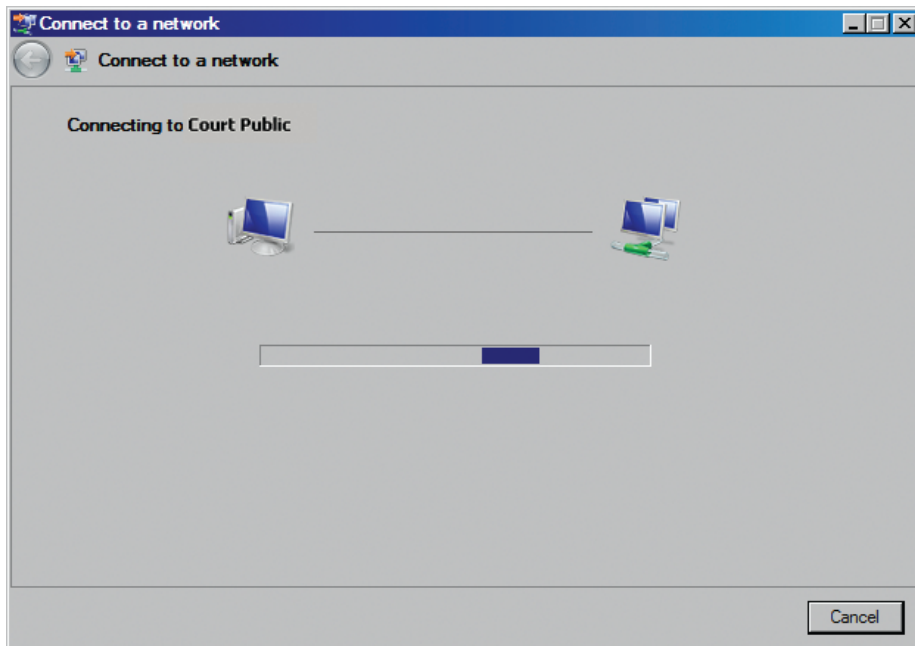
Select **Court Public** and click on the **Connect** button.



You may be warned about it being an unsecured network. Click on ***Connect Anyway***.



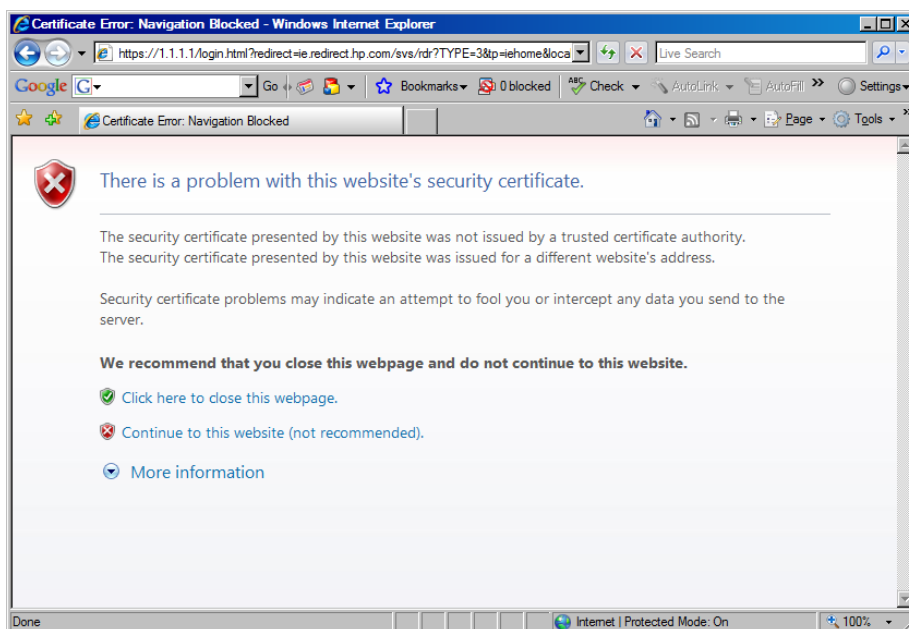
This may take a few seconds to connect.
