




Superior Court of California, County of Solano Wireless Access: Windows XP

The court provides a free Internet access point or "hot spot" for the benefit of the Public (during normal business hours) that have portable computers capable of receiving wireless signals. This will allow users to access the Internet from their laptop computers when sitting within range of an access point. The following is a step by step instructional on how to connect to the wireless network using Windows XP.

Go to **Start** and select **Connect To** and choose **Wireless Network Connection**.




Click on **Court Public** to highlight and click on the **Connect** button.




It will take a few seconds to connect.



You should now be connected.




Now you need to open up a web browser. You will see a warning about the security certificate which is expected. Click on ***Continue to this Website (not recommended)***.



Enter *Public* for the User Name and *Solano* for the Password at the Login screen.

Note: Both User Name and Password are case sensitive.



You are now connected to the Internet and will be greeted with the following homepage for the Superior Court of California, County of Solano.



When you are through browsing the Internet, click the *Logout* button on the *Web Authentication* screen to terminate your session.
