COURT ANNOUNCES NEW ASSISTANT CEO

The Superior Court of California, County of Solano announces the appointment of Robert Oliver as Assistant Court Executive Officer, effective January 4, 2016.

Prior to his appointment as Assistant CEO with the Solano Court, Mr. Oliver served as a Principal Analyst with the Contra Costa Superior Court and as a Court Administrative Analyst with the Napa Superior Court. He has worked as an analyst with the University of California, San Francisco. He holds a Masters of Public Administration from the University of San Francisco and a Bachelor of Arts in Communications from Kent State University. He is certified as a Court Manager from the Institute of Court Management, National Center for State Courts.

Mr. Oliver said, "I am honored to be afforded the opportunity to serve as Assistant Court Executive Officer for the Solano Superior Court. I look forward to working with the judges and staff to continue to provide high-level services for the people of Solano County."

"I am pleased the judges have confirmed the appointment of Mr. Oliver as Assistant Court Executive Officer" said Brian Taylor, Court Executive Officer. "Mr. Oliver brings a wealth of knowledge and experience from his work at the Napa and Contra Costa courts. He will be an asset to Solano County."

Mr. Oliver replaces Sharon Hoover who is retiring December 30, 2015 after 28 years of service to the Solano Superior Court. Ms. Hoover began her career with the court in 1987 as a judicial secretary. In December 1994, she was promoted to Civil Case Management Coordinator. One year later Ms. Hoover was promoted to Civil Division Program Manager. She was appointed as the Deputy Court Executive Officer in May 2005, and as Assistant CEO in December 2007. She is a graduate of the Institute for Court Management, National Center for State Courts.

The Superior Court of Solano County is the unified trial court of both general and limited jurisdiction. Comprised of 23 judicial officers and a staff of 206, the court has jurisdiction of all cases arising within the county, including all felony, misdemeanor, traffic, civil, small claims, family law, probate and juvenile cases. The Assistant CEO is second in command for all non-judicial operations of the Court.
