1. In addition to mailed notice, the law requires that notice of the hearing be published. There is no affidavit of publication on file as required by Probate Code section 8124. // Issue previously identified and not resolved.
2. *Petition*, Item 1: This section must be completed. // Issue previously identified and not resolved.
3. *Petition*, Item 2: The petitioner's name must be listed. // Issue previously identified and not resolved.
4. *Petition*, Item 2(d): This item must be addressed. // Issue previously identified and not resolved.
5. *Petition*, Item 3(e)(2): The date of the will is inconsistent with the original will on file. A copy of the will is not attached to the petition. // Issue previously identified and not resolved.
6. *Petition*, Item 5(a): Item (3) or (4) must be completed. Item (7) or (8) must be completed. // Issue previously identified and not resolved.

7. *Petition*, Item 8: The petitioner must provide her information. // Issue previously identified and not resolved.

RECOMMENDATION

Recommend denial without prejudice.
