Adult Drug Court to Hold Graduation

The Superior Court of California, County of Solano, is pleased to announce that it will be celebrating the tenth graduation ceremony for its Adult Drug Court program on December 16, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. at the Fairfield Law and Justice Center in Department 8 with the Honorable Wendy G. Getty presiding. Participants who have successfully completed the Adult Drug Court program will be recognized for their hard work, achievements and dedication in maintaining their sobriety.

As stated by Judge Getty, "Drug Court graduation is a celebration of remarkable achievement by people who have made the choice to change their lives. It is the opportunity to formally recognize individuals who have worked hard to overcome personal adversity, to achieve and maintain sobriety and to create better futures for themselves and their loved ones."

Established in 2007, Solano County's Adult Drug Court program provides participants with the resources and judicial supervision needed to recover from drug use. Like other drug courts, the court is non-adversarial and involves a "team" of players that work together to promote participants' recovery. The team includes Solano County's District Attorney's Office, Public Defender's Office, Conflict Defender's Office, Probation Department and Health and Social Services Department.

Earlier this year, the court was awarded two federal grants which will allow the court to increase the number of participants served by the Fairfield courthouse and has already supported the establishment of a new drug court program in the Vallejo courthouse.
